Scheduling and Setting

	\square Agenda and schedule are available ahead of time
1	☐ Agenda and/or schedule are present in writing and discussed
	□ Schedule allows for breaks
	□ Group expectations are presented in writing and discussed
	 Arrangement of area allows clear, direct views of speakers and materials
	□ Arrangement of area has limited distractions
	☐ Arrangement of area allows for easy accessibility throughout
<u>Pre</u>	sentation and Instruction
	☐ Materials are provided ahead of time when available
1	□ Materials are available in print sizes 12 point or large print
	□ Materials are available auditorily or discussed auditorily
1	□ Closed caption or sign language interpreter when needed
1	\square Information is amplified in large groups with the use of microphones
1	□ Information presented auditorily involves speakers facing members
	 Topical discussions involve multiple modes of instruction: print, auditory, use of media, hands on, etc.
١	□ Use of materials are provided at a variety of instructional levels
1	 Leaders check for understanding throughout presentation
1	□ Participants are given multiple ways to participate in discussions:
	written, oral, use of phone app questionnaires, etc.
